

AUTHOR GUIDELINES FOR MANUSCRIPT SUBMISSION

and

'ASPECTS OF HISTORICAL MUSICOLOGY'

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The text of the article is accepted for consideration in case there is a complete package of supporting documents in digital format, which includes:

1. **Cover Letter** / license agreement for publication in a scientific journal and posting the article on the Internet.
2. **Author(s) Application Form** in two languages: English and Ukrainian.

The text of the article must be submitted in electronic form by e-mail to hnum.nauka@gmail.com. The subject of the letter is "author's last name_article". The file format must be *doc*. The name of the file – author's last name transcribed in Latin alphabet: Perenko.doc .

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THE SEQUENCE OF STRUCTURAL ELEMENTS OF THE ARTICLE

Language of the article: Ukrainian, English.

The main text of the article (without abstracts and bibliography) should contain **20000-40000** characters including spaces.

UDC index – alignment on the left edge;

Last name and initials of the author – centre alignment, italics, bold;

ORCID ID number (required) – centre alignment, regular font;

Title of the article – capital letters, bold, centre alignment.

Descriptive abstract in Ukrainian language must contain 900 characters including spaces. Required elements: statement of problem, purpose, novelty, conclusions. Key words: 5-10, phrases are considered one keyword.

THE MAIN TEXT OF THE ARTICLE should contain the following structural elements:

Statement of the problem with indication of relevance and novelty of the topic, its relation to practical tasks (5-10 lines). **Analysis of recent research and publications** which highlights pending issues of the general problem to which the article is devoted. Manuscripts should include references to articles published within the last five years, foreign scientific sources, including those indexed in Scopus and WoS (at least 50% of the total number of sources in the reference list);

The purpose of the article.

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Presentation of basic research material with full justification of the obtained research findings;

Conclusions – research findings with indication of the prospects for further research in the field.

References are arranged in accordance with the international standard APA Style and must contain the titles of the works the author refers to. If the Background section or other parts of the text contain reference to the name of a researcher – his/her publication must be mentioned in the complete reference list presented after the article. The list should contain from 10 to 20 references. The titles of works should be arranged in alphabetical order and not numbered. Reference lists should be followed by a DOI (if available).

References to unpublished works are not allowed. The reference list cannot consist only of website links. References to newspapers, production journals, textbooks and the authors' own publications should be avoided. Intext citation and references should be presented according to the international standard of APA Style. The author's name is followed by the year of publication, and after the colon the quoted page should be mentioned, e.g. (Ivanchenko, 1989: 235).

In the English-language article the reference list is to be arranged in the original language (i.e. Ukr., Rus., Eng., etc.).

Information about the author in English, which must be identical to the Ukrainian version, the title of the article and an informative abstract in English (2500 characters including spaces) are placed after the Reference List preceding the transliterated References list.

An informative abstract should be meaningful (no general words), original (no copy version of the Ukrainian descriptive abstract), content-related (reflect the main content of the article and research findings), structural (include all the principal elements: Statement of the problem; Analysis of recent research and publications; The purpose of the research; The scientific novelty; Methods of the research; Presentation of basic research material; Conclusions. The informative abstract should end with *Key words* (5-10). The English abstract is included in the article and is submitted as a separate document, certified by the translator's signature and the seal at their place of work.

References – the reference list translated into English must be arranged according to the international standard of APA (American Psychological Association) Style.

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Figures and tables are placed with center alignment. No text wrapping around figures and tables. Figures and tables must be placed on the page immediately following the textual reference. Each formula, figure, table and chart must be referred to in the text. The formulas referenced are numbered in Arabic numerals in parentheses on the right. Tables should be compact, have a name and number.

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
